- Friday, March 21st at 9:30 am & *11:30 am

Ticket Prices:

- Student Tickets: \$10
- One teacher and one para-pro per class attend free of charge.
- Additional adult/chaperone tickets: \$10 each (please include these in your reservation form).
- Homeschool groups can have one adult chaperone per 10 children at no additional cost; otherwise, accompanying adults must purchase tickets (please include these in your reservation form).

Reservation Process:

- Completing this form is required but does not guarantee a reservation.

Reservation Availability: Reservation availability depends on the seats available at the time of my request's submission and is on a first-come, first-served basis. My reservation is tentative until GBC receives payment for the invoice.

Reservation Guarantee: GBC will send an invoice via email to the field trip coordinator listed on the reservation form. To guarantee your reservation, the invoice must be paid in full by **MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2025**. If GBC does not receive payment by that date, GBC reserves the right to release your reservation to another party.

Special Seating Requests: GBC will try to honor special requests if possible but holds no guarantee or promises—special requests for accommodated seating for students with special needs are notwithstanding.

Payment Information:

- All funds must be collected by the school/co-op groups.

- Upon receipt of payment, the GBC will email the field trip coordinator a receipt, reservation confirmation, arrival/parking instructions, and a Little Mermaid Lesson Plan.

Invoice & Refund Policy: Invoices are created based on the number of students and adults/chaperones listed on the reservation form. **Invoices must be PAID IN FULL by MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2025.** Please note that all sales are final; tickets are non-refundable. No tickets are sold at the door at the time of the performance. Should extenuating circumstances arise, GBC reserves the right to issue a 5% adjustment at the sole discretion of our Executive Director. Reservations may not be altered once payment is received.
